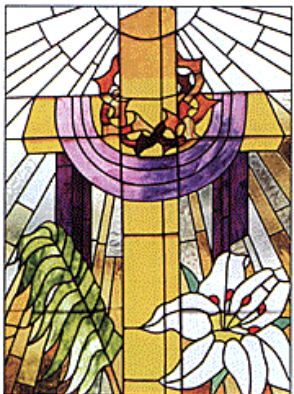

The meeting was closed with the Benediction at 11:40 a.m.

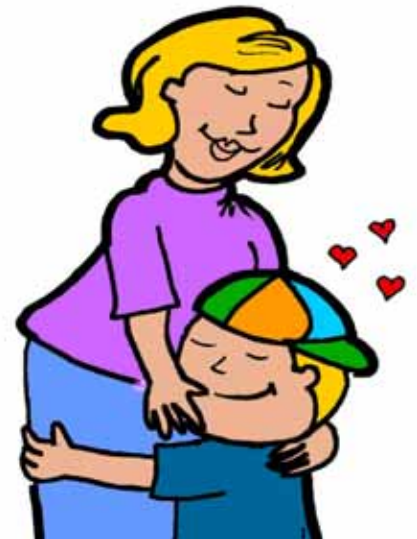
