We are in the charming area of Hyde Park, on a corner lot, nestled beneath a canopy of 150 year old oak trees.


The large lawn is covered by gorgeous flowers and greenery that change throughout the year.

The history of Hyde Park Presbyterian is as unique as the love and faith of its congregation.

In 1910, the doors opened with 13 members. In 1948, an army mess hall was added and named Wooten Hall after devoted member Ed Wooten.

Soon after, the home next door was bought. It serves as the pastor's office, meeting and Sunday School space and for bridal dressing. In 2010, it was named Mavis' House after beloved member Mavis Buck.

The church was listed with the National Register of Historic Places in 1990. All buildings and grounds are consistently updated to better serve everyone who enters the doors.

We are comprised of multi-generational families, students, couples of all ages and individuals with a focus on fellowship, faith and community.

Over 110 years later, a focus of Hyde Park Presbyterian remains on uniting couples in marriage in a space rich in love and character.
